

**The Frederick C. Robbins Fellowship and the Thomas M. and Janet S. Daniel
Student Fellowship Application 2012**

The Center for Global Health and Diseases administers the Frederick C. Robbins and Thomas M. and Janet S. Daniel Student Fellowships to assist fourth year medical students perform international clinical research electives. Students in the class of 2013 are eligible to apply for this award. Applications will be judged competitively.

Deadline: Proposals must be submitted electronically on or before **Friday, April 6, 2012.**

Eligibility: The **Frederick C. Robbins** and **Thomas M. and Janet S. Daniel Student Fellowships** are available to fourth year medical students (class of 2013) who are in good academic standing, have completed their core clerkships in Medicine, Pediatrics, and Surgery, and have passed the USMLE part I examination. Complete and eligible applications to these fellowships that are not awarded will automatically be considered for the SOM Travel Award.

Terms: The **Frederick C. Robbins** and **Thomas M. and Janet S. Daniel Student Fellowships** provide \$1,800 to support international travel for a period of one or two months. International travel for these awards is travel to a country typically considered "developing." For support, an elective must have a substantial research or patient contact component. Language courses are not considered eligible. The awards will be made competitively on the basis of written proposals submitted by applicants. All sections of this application must be submitted before the deadline.

To apply for the Frederick C. Robbins Fellowship and the Thomas M. and Janet S. Daniel Student Fellowship (as well as considered for the CASE School of Medicine Travel Award 2012), complete all four sections below and email the entire document to the program administrator, Carmel Gambatese at "carmel.gambatese@case.edu" no later than Friday April 6, 2012.

PART II: Title and Abstract

- a) State the title of your Fellowship proposal.
- b) Provide an abstract of the proposed travel and activities to be undertaken with support of the fellowship. Limit the abstract to 7,000 characters (with spaces).

PART III: Essay

Please provide a description of your proposed international elective. This should include a statement of your proposed *objectives*, the clinical or research *activities* you expect to undertake, the *setting* in which they will occur, *the instruction/supervision* you will receive, the method of your *evaluation*, and the *impact* this experience will have on you and your medical research career. Also include a short *budget* and *timeline* for your elective activities. The essay must not exceed 2,550 words.

PART IV: Curriculum vitae

Please attach a current and accurate *curriculum vitae* (c.v.). This should include your Name, Contact Information, Academic History (e.g., Program, Degree, Institution, Dates of Registration), Relevant Experience (e.g., Employer/Lab/Organization, Dates of the experience, Position, and Tasks), Skills (e.g., Language, Other relevant skills to your proposal), and Awards.
